- Procedure
- Equipment
- Technical
 - Hematology (CBC, VS, Morpology, Group, Malaria, Hemostar......)
 - Biochemistry(Gly, Cal, Tri, Cho, Acide, Transamina, Creatinine, Uree, Amylase, Bilirobin,)
 - Serology (HBS, HCV, HIV, RPR, TPHA, Widal, CRP, ASLO, FR.....)
 - Micro logy (TB, Urine, stool)
 - Blood Bank (Cross Match, Blood Doner)

Plan

- ► Monthly SOPs Writing: 3 person X 2 week/ month = 6 SOPs
 - QA
 - Biosafety Officer
 - Equipment officer

Do

Process

- > 1 Weekly meeting: Choose SOPs to write.
- > 2 Weekly meeting: Review SOPs next weekly meeting
- > 3 Weekly meeting: Final Draft and Choose new SOPs
- > 4 Weekly meeting: the same 2 week

Study

- Follow up previous meeting
- Listen feed back
- Collect Information
- Study again

Act

- ► Try new trial
- Adjustments on SOPs
- Renew Cycle
